## Maths

Number

- Please try to learn how to count forwards and backwards from 20 as often as possible.
- Listen to Jack Hartmann count to 20 forwards and backwards video on YouTube

Shapes

- Try to watch a range of 2d and 3d shapes videos on YouTube, recapping on what the shapes are called, and how many sides each shape has.
- Try to sequence breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Try to place objects in/out of a container when requested.
- Try to identify something you do during the day.

UAS

- Can I create my own pattern with two colours?
